SPEEDWATCH NEEDS YOU!

The North Curry Speedwatch Group is in urgent need of a co-ordinator. The co-ordinator acts as a central contact point, organising Speedwatch sessions and submitting data online. There is a team of 6 Speedwatch volunteers who are ready and willing to undertake sessions (2 or 3 volunteers being needed for each session) and the role would not be too time consuming. The co-ordinator need not take part in the Speedwatch sessions themselves (although would be welcome to do so subject to undergoing the necessary short training and approval). If you have a small amount of time to spare and an interest in improving road safety in the Parish please consider taking on this role, without a co-ordinator the Speedwatch Group may need to fold.



Apple juicing


We know it's only July but it's never too early to plan ahead!
